What is Walk & Knock?

- Walk & Knock is the nation's largest, local one-day food drive
- We solicit charitable donations of food, supplies and money, which in turn are given to the Clark County Food Bank for providing food to those in need across our community
- Begins at 9am on the first Saturday of December
- **This year it is December 5th, 2020**

Where is it?

- **Walk & Knock encompasses all of metropolitan Clark County**
- **Volunteers can choose where to work when they sign up online**
- **Volunteers come from the Lions, Kiwanis, Rotary, Clark County Amateur Radio Club, Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts, local church groups, high school clubs, and many other organizations**
- **And hundreds of other individuals**
- **10 Major Sections, each split down even further**

How It Works

- Walk & Knock distributes grocery bags throughout the county the week before the food drive
- People fill the bags with non-perishable food and toiletries
- And they put them on their porches by 9 a.m. on Drive Day

Then...

- Volunteers go door-to-door collecting the bags and delivering them to one of 10 drop-off locations
- The donated food is boxed by volunteers and delivered to the Food Bank in 10 donated semis

And Finally...

The Clark County Food Bank distributes the collected food to more than 2 dozen food pantries, which give to those in need.



Who Are We?

- **Clark County Inter-service Walk & Knock is a non-profit, 501(c)(3) charitable organization**
- **We are governed by a Board of Trustees elected by our members: Lions, Kiwanis, Rotary, and the Clark County Amateur Radio Club**
- **We are all-volunteers -- no staff**
- **No public funds are used for anything other than for the purchase of food**
- **Walk & Knock is 100% privately funded by about 20 local sponsors**

What Have We Done?

- **Collected over 8.8 million pounds of food valued at \$14.8 million**
- **Provided 7.3 million meals**
- **Donated over \$300,000 for the purchase of food**
- **Enlisted tens of thousands of volunteers over our 35 years**

Drive & Drop

- No W&K bags given out
- No bag folding
- No W&K door-to-door collections
- No thousands of volunteers

Drive & Drop

- Mail out 186,000 postcards
- Ask people to donate money
- Or Drive to a collection site and Drop off a donation of food in their own bags
- We will use 7 – 10 drop sites
- People will drop donations in large tote boxes
- Our volunteers will put the boxes into donated semi-trailers and volunteer drivers will take the donations to the Food Bank

Drive & Drop

- **Is safe!**
- **Has very little interpersonal contact**
- **Fulfills W&K's 36-year mission of supporting the Clark County Food Bank**
